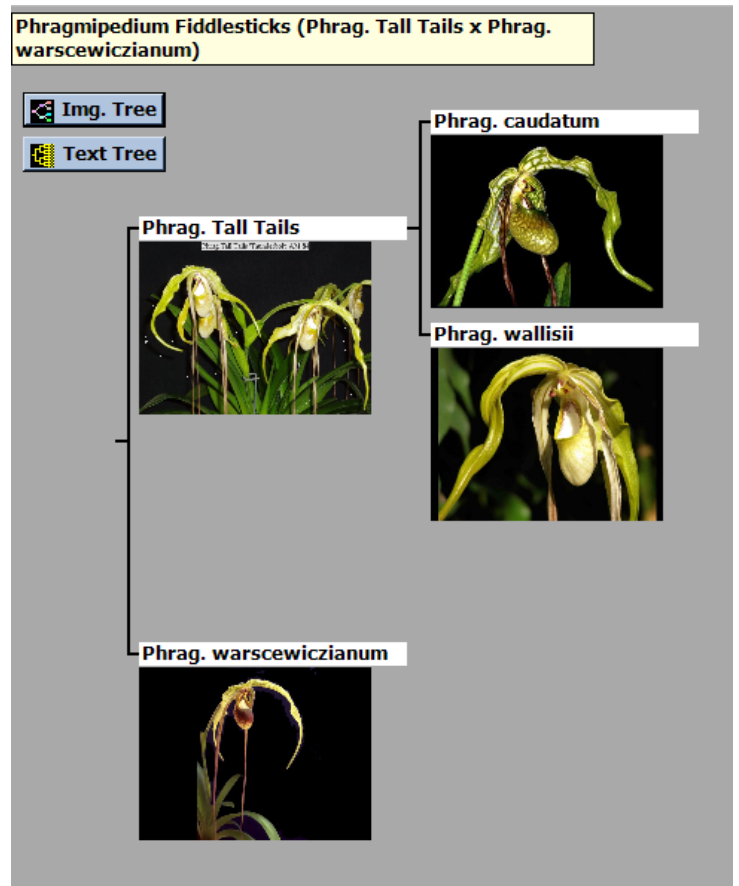


Phragmipedium Fiddlesticks 'Max' AM/AOS

Given the parentage of Phrag. Fiddlesticks 'Max', this hybrid should be grown in bright indirect light conditions with 60%-70% humidity. Temperatures should be cool to intermediate (58°F to 75°F at night). Phragmipediums should not be allowed to dry out between waterings. Grow in a plastic pot with media that drains well but retains moisture. Commonly cultivated indoors. Fertilize weekly, very lightly (one quarter the normal dose). Common media: fine fir bark, with a little perlite.
